



Nickel City Sons AAA Head Coach Selection Process

HEAD COACH CRITERIAS SOUGHT

1. The applicant should have successful hockey coaching experience.
2. The applicant must have knowledge of the NCS and NOHA constitution, procedures and policies.
3. A written hockey season plan must be submitted at the interview. It is understood to be a draft, meaning that changes can be expected. *(see note 1, below)*
4. If your son is trying out for the team and you want to coach, a separate committee, made up of three members of the executive, will be the determining factor if your son is picked for the team.
5. The Coach will be required to take part in Spring ice (April & May) and off ice testing, and fall testing, and will continue through the season with off ice training.
6. It is expected that the coach & team staff continue there coaching education by applying and taking part all levels of certification, and special coaching programs. The Nickel City Son's will provide financial assistance.
7. All Coach's (Peewee/Bantam/Midget) will work together to assure the best possible continual training flowchart, and will meet to discuss at the start of the year, and will continue throughout the season.

HOCKEY SEASON PLAN

It shall compose of the following elements:

Fair play, Values and Ethics

(Values form the basis of our coaching philosophy)

Ethics;

Ethical responsibilities to players and the staff

Respect being clear and up front

Coaching Responsibility to create a practice and competition environment

The progression emphasis on fundamental skills and team tactic's and individual tactic's

Outline of players & parents meetings
